SB1274	<p>Short Title: An Act relating to child care facilities; amending 10 O.S. 2011, Section 404.3, as amended by Section 5, Chapter 308, O.S.L. 2013 (10 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 404.3), which relates to mandatory liability insurance; providing statutory reference; requiring facilities to maintain certain records onsite; specifying criteria for certain forms; clarifying language; directing promulgation of rules; and declaring an emergency. (Amended by House, Amended by Senate, Emergency Measure)</p> <p>Paraphrase: SB1274, by Sen. Kay Floyd, D-Oklahoma City and Rep. Josh Cockroft, R-Tecumseh, requires that certain notices in child care facilities concerning insurance be placed conspicuously and in accordance with specific requirements. The bill requires child care facilities to maintain compliance files. It requires the Department of Human Services to promulgate necessary rules. (Amended by Senate, Constitutional Amendment)</p> <p>Paraphrase: SJR0072, by Sen. Robert Standridge, R-Norman and Rep. John Jordan, R-Yukon, proposes a vote of the people to repeal Article 2, Section 5 of the Oklahoma Constitution, which prohibits the use public monies or property for sectarian or religious purposes.
